Summit Administration, the Crisis Management Team, and the Board of Trustees continue to closely monitor developments with the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Yesterday, the city of Springfield Mayor, Ken McClure, and Greene County Presiding Commissioner, Bob Dixon, issued a "[stay at home](#)" order for Greene County that will go into effect on Thursday, March 26th and last through Friday, April 24th.
