Financial Update - Amy Maas

Finance Report, 10/26/21

- Note: 8th graders sold pumpkins and mums purchased for Fall Extravaganza to raise money for their 8th grade class trip
- Tess Hemphill asked for clarification on distribution of SPO funds from end of 2020-2021 year to the beginning of 2021-2022 year. Other reps voiced similar questions on how class funds were calculated and delineated this year. Amy Maas outlined what was communicated with the distribution of class funds this summer and said she would follow up on specific budget questions for the November meeting.
- It was reiterated that no changes have been made to the SPO budget since the September 2021 SPO meeting. Admin has continued to work with event committee volunteers, teacher appreciation committee volunteers, and other parent volunteers to sustain the commitments and expectations that were communicated regarding specific events and appreciation gifts, including Donuts with Grownups, employee birthdays, and teacher appreciation.
- The SPO funds continue to be held in the school's account as a restricted budget line item and have not been absorbed by the school's operating budget. Admin is happy to provide a summary report of all SPO finances to class reps and the information will continue to be reported in the monthly SPO meeting.
- Class reps have received their specific class fund amount budgeted for the 2021-2022 school year to use for classroom and faculty support as outlined in the summer 2021 packets of information for SPO. (Class SPO Funds and Handout to Parents on what Class Fund would be used for)
- Nikki Keiper asked if class reps should still use the <u>same link for reimbursement</u> requests. Amy Maas replied Yes. There is no change to the reimbursement request procedure for class reps. The only change to the procedure is that Dr. Heet receives and approves all reimbursement requests in the absence of an SPO President and VP of Finance.

Review of Class Rep Expectations for 2021-2022

- Expectations of SPO Reps were reviewed and remain the same as what was presented to reps in Summer 2021 (August 2021 Class Rep Checklist).
 - It was noted that the Gala Class Project has been removed from SPO Rep responsibilities and is not an expectation for reps to create or provide but an optional item to donate if a class or class rep feels the desire to do so. Amy Maas mentioned that if anyone is interested in auction item procurement to please let admin know as they are looking for committee members for the Gala Auction Committee.
 - Jennifer Black asked that if a class were to donate or make an item for the auction, would they still be recognized and advertised as such. Amy confirmed that yes, that would be noted in the auction item description and recognition would go towards that class' auction item.
 - SPO will continue meeting monthly at the times calendared for the 2021-2022 school year.
- A question was asked about winter party expectations and attendance. More information about winter class parties will be discussed at the November SPO meeting.
- A question was asked about clarification on teacher birthdays. Amy Maas said that all employee birthdays thus far this year have been recognized and celebrated through the Teacher Appreciation Committee and other volunteers. The committee has continued to follow the outlined employee gift giving expectations set forth by the former SPO Exec Committee, within the SPO budget guidelines. Teacher birthday gifts are not an expectation of class reps.
 - However, in the absence of details on holiday gift giving, employee holiday gifts are at the discretion of class reps. These are not an expectation.
 - Jennifer Black asked about gift giving guidelines. In accordance with school policy, employees should not receive more than \$25.00 in gifts from any one individual. There is no monetary limit set on employee gifts received from a class or other group as a collective.
- Nikki Keiper asked about the possibility of future events on campus this year, such as the possibility of another community gathering before Winter Break. Amy Maas answered that there is the continued opportunity for on campus events, but admin will need at least until next week (after the open house) to begin thinking about planning additional events. Dr. Heet stated that admin is short staffed and is not sure we can take on many additional events than those already scheduled. It was noted that there is not a chair for the Trivia Night or Spring Carnival at this time. Student Council may be interested in a spring talent show, but has not been confirmed.
 - Class reps in attendance expressed support of hosting community events on campus since it appears we still have the budget to do so this year.
