## Statement of Expectation

For students to gain the most out of their experience at The Summit, it is imperative that they understand how important participation in the learning process is to their success here. Summit educators expect our international students to stay engaged and practice their spoken English everyday. Although reading and written work will be part of your education, verbal participation is crucial. Failure to participate in group discussions/projects could result in dismissal from the school.

#### 1. Apply

- Submit complete application with \$200 USD non-refundable application fee.
- Provide confidential teacher recommendation to current/previous instructors (which must be returned by the instructor directly to The Summit).
- Submit English Proficiency Test Scores, if available, and wirting sample
- Have transcripts/school records, both original and English translation, sent to The Summit from the current school year and previous two years

#### 2. Interview

• The School will contact the student to schedule a screening interview with Summit staff in person or via video-chat once all application materials have been reviewed.

#### 3. Admission Decision

- The student/responsible party will be notified if he/she is admitted for the upcoming school year and provided an enrollment contract with due date.
- Upon acceptance, official, sealed transcripts must be sent to The Summit and \$500 USD first year enrollment fee is due (this amount is applied to final tuition due).

## 4. Complete Enrollment

- The Summit will issue the I-20 Form once enrollment fee and signed enrollment contract is received.
- Immunization records and emergency contact information must be submitted by the responsible party.

## 5. Remaining tuition balance paid in full (USD) by first day of school.
